DSWF Schools' Global Canvas Art Competition 2018

'Into The Wild'

We are inviting group entries for our Global Canvas 2018 competition.

We are asking groups (eg your art club, class, year or school) to interpret this year's theme: **'Into The Wild'**

Each group's entry should be created to fill a wall space 6x6ft and a table 6ftx2ft. Be as creative as you can using art and sculpture to create your own mini-exhibition.

Set your exhibition up at school and submit a **photograph** of your entry plus **200 words** describing how you have interpreted the theme.

Please also submit a **video or PowerPoint presentation** which will be shown at the Natural History Museum if you are selected as a winner (videos must be no more than 3 minutes long).

Shortlisted winners will be chosen from the photographic submission and video/presentation. The successful groups will be invited to recreate their display at the Natural History Museum between 10-12am on the morning of the event on **Thursday 15th March 2018**.

Judging to select the final 3 winners will take place between 12-1pm with the guest speakers talk and prize giving between 1:30-3:00pm.

Age Groups

Open to everyone aged 16 and under
(Whether you do it by class, year or whole school - the choice is yours)

Entry is FREE

Donations are welcome but will not affect judging
Suggested donation £20

Prizes

Each shortlisted entry will receive a certificate and a goody bag with the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places chosen from the exhibited shortlist. The top three will receive cash prizes generously donated by the event sponsor, Michael O'Mara Books, for the furtherance of art or conservation education projects at the winning school or artclub.
1st prize = £200, 2nd prize = £150, 3rd prize = £100

Photographs and entry details should be submitted by **Thursday 1st February 2018**.

15 group entries from across all age ranges will be shortlisted and exhibited at the Natural History Museum in London on **March 15th 2018** and will be judged on the day by DSWF and the guest speaker.

Terms and Conditions

- Each entry must comprise the work of children all of whom are aged 16 and under
- Each entry must interpret the theme "Into The Wild"
- All entries must be received by email by 1st February 2018
- Donations can be made either by cheque made payable to 'DSWF' (please include the name of the group / school you are paying for) or by calling the office Mon-Fri 9am-5pm on 01483 272323.
- First, second and third place will be awarded group prizes.
- The decision of the judges will be final
- It is the responsibility of the shortlisted winners to ensure that all materials for their display are brought to and set up at the Natural History Museum between 10-12am on March 15th and removed after the event.
- Once shortlisted all the overseas shortlisted winners must ensure that their work reaches the David Shepherd Wildlife Foundation offices (address below) in time for the David Shepherd team to set up the display as per the submitted photo entry.
- First, second and third winners will have their submitted video/presentation played at the Natural History Museum. Should shortlists wish to prepare these for student delivery on Thursday 15th March 2018, they will be invited to present themselves.
- Please ensure that any student who appears in a video or presentation that is submitted has permission for their photograph to be used. Any video or presentation that is submitted may be used on our website or social media platforms.
- Entries will be judged on the quality of art, interpretation of the theme, level of collaboration and creativity.
- Any groups shortlisted for the event and final judging will be allocated 12 places. These can be made up of participating students, teachers and / or parents. Numbers are strictly limited by the capacity of the Flett Theatre.

Each entry must be submitted as per the following:

- completed entry form
- photograph
- video or presentation of no more than 3 minutes long

We recommend submitting your entry using a file transfer tool such as DropBox, WeTransfer or Google Drive, then sending the link along with your completed application form to:
