Manifesto

Material are the elements that bind together to form an architecture that we appreciate every day. The ability to make good architecture is one, but being true to it till the material level is another. What stands out when we appreciate architecture rooted at the material level is the fact that, irrespective of scale / budget / limitations / challenges / design liberty, **getting things elementally right** - is what differentiates good architecture from the rest. Good spaces entice mental and emotional wellbeing, but materials are the interface to these good vibes. They constantly speak to our sense which gives us a feeling of positivity within.

Tactile is an Architecture Awards Programme that recognizes exceptional architecture at the material level. Tactile explores excellence in detailing of building design. The spotlight here is extended to details that are fundamental to any architectural design but often go undiscovered as the dialogue today around architecture is too broad to look at these.

Tactile aims to spread awareness about these small yet powerful innovations that makes architecture possible and the efforts of designers who make them. **Tactile** is a part of A4A ([A for Architecture](#) '20 Awards) details to be out soon.

The submission will look more at innovative material used explained through photographs, detail sketches, process, detail in drawing, and its overall contribution to architecture at large. The following categories are invited to participate in this Awards programme.

Wood

noun US /wʊd/

Buildings making use of trunks of trees, timber, lumber, wooden elements in architecture.

Stone

noun US /stəʊn/

Buildings making innovative use of stone, or any mineral rock, in the architectural delivery.

Concrete

noun US /'kɒŋkri:t/

Buildings pushing the use of concrete from traditional columns and slabs, to more unusual yet meaningful form of design.

Composites

noun US /'kɒmpəzɪt/

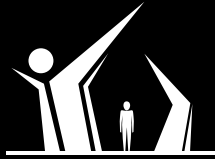
Architecture making use of blend of materials of natural or synthetic origins.

Buildings making use any exceptional details exploring uses of metal.

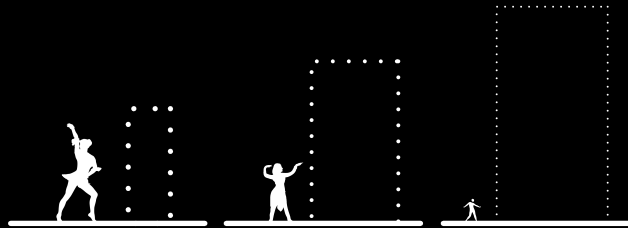

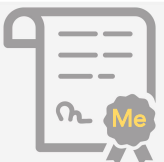

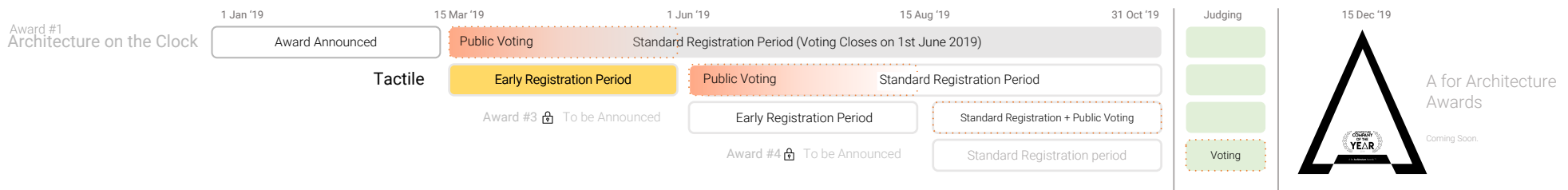
