### THE PROGRAME.

The Design of the house should be innovative and creative with a sustainable edge. Mobility should be addressed as an integral component. The house need not be self-mobile but should be treated more as an extension which can easily be towed by a Car or Pickup truck.

The relation between the exterior and interior spaces ought to be taken into consideration. The proposal should be well conceptualized. Most importantly, the area of the house should not exceed 250 sq.ft.

The Interior Program Spaces include:

Living Area | Sleeping Area for 2 | Cooking and Dining Area One Toilet | Workspace.

Client Interaction is one of the critical components of the design proposal.

For the purpose of this competition, entrants may assume an individual, couple, or a genre of people, based on the design concept.



# SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The entrants must complete the online registration and the Submissions must include, but are not limited to, the following required drawings:

- Three-dimensional representations in the form of axonometric, perspectives or montages which illustrate the character of the project
- Building / Site sections which illustrate key aspects and major spatial or programmatic elements
- Floor Plans to show the interior spatial arrangement and program elements
- Elevations demonstrating qualities such as materials, texture, and color.
- Large scale drawing that illustrate innovative details or integrated aspects of design.

All drawings should be presented at a scale appropriate to the design solution and include a graphic scale for reference.



#### SUBMISSION FORMAT

2 landscape oriented A3 sheet.

The sheet must be submitted in two formats

300 dpi resolution | File type :PDF | Maximum size 20 MB |

72 dpi resolution | File type :PDF | Maximum size | MB | File Name – Project I.D.\_72.pdf

All files must be marked with your project ID, presented clearly in the top right-hand corner of all your submitted files. There should be a single zipped folder named with your project I.D. and deliverables.

The sheets MUST NOT include ANY INFORMATION (Name, Organisation, School etc.) that may give away your identity.

All text must be in ENGLISH, with a MAXIMUM of 250 WORDS for project explanation ( to be provided on the A3 sheets itself )

The design addressing the factors of environmental efficiency, self-sufficiency, mobility.
